- Data in each line are separated with semicolon (;)
- The first line is a Header line and always exists
 - The first field in the Header line is always Trading day in format DD.MM.YYYY.
 - All other fields in Header line are names of fields which will be saved in the file in other data lines:
 - Example of Header line:

05.12.2014;TradeTime;Ticket;Symbol;ISIN;Issuer;Volume;Price;Value;Interest

- All other lines in the file represent block trades, each line represents one block trade. Data are as follows, in this order:
 - o TradeDate
 - o TradeTime
 - o Ticket o Symbol
 - o ISIN
